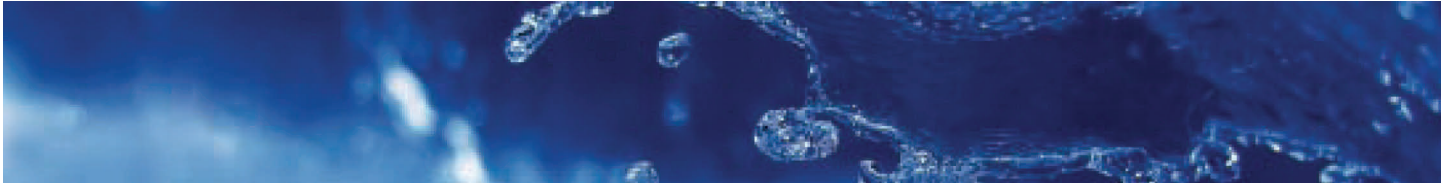

Project Overview:

Aldershot Garrison Sports Centre houses a 50m 10 lane competition pool, based in the North Camp Military Town, Aldershot, Hampshire.

The chemical rooms for the swimming pool water treatment system had suffered from a significant chemical spillage. As a result, dividing walls between the chemical rooms and bunds had been compromised and there was a significant risk of chemical corrosion and fumes reaching other areas of the building.

The project for F.T. Leisure Limited comprised of the replacement of chemically damaged pipework supports and equipment and the complete lining of the chemical areas. The linings were designed to segregate the chemicals from each other.

F T Leisure specialist fabricators applied PVC sheeting to the floor and walls and the chemical bunds. The PVC sheeting is then sealed and spark tested to ensure that any possible future spillages are contained.

At the request of the Client ,the lining to the chemical rooms was supplied with an anti-slip finish created in our in-house shot-blasting facility to British Standards for non-slip finishes. This surface ensure that the operators are not at risk of injury should there be any spillages on the floor of the chemical rooms.
